

Receiving SCC Deliveries

Understanding Your SCC Delivery and Dating Frozen Product



Consider using this optional resource that helps explain paperwork from your Supply Chain Center deliveries and provides information on dating frozen product.

This resource provides information to help you understand the paperwork that comes with your SCC deliveries. The paperwork provided by the SCC driver will depend on the system the local SCC uses. You will either receive a "Packing List" (below left) or a "Store Delivery Sheet" with an invoice (below right). Check out the boxes below to learn more about what information is included in your SCC paperwork.

NOTE: Using this paperwork will help you ensure correct dating of frozen product that comes from the SCC. When dating frozen product, it is recommended that you **USE THE EXPIRATION DATES FOUND ON THIS PAPERWORK**. Using these expiration dates will ensure that your frozen product will be dated with the correct shelf life.

ORDERED – Quantities that your organization entered into the EFO tool when placing your order.


SHIPPED – Quantities that were delivered to your store. Your store will be billed based on the quantities in **this** column.

PACKING LIST

EXPIRATION DATE – Use the dates in **this** column when dating frozen product.

STORE CHECK – Check these boxes verifying you **RECEIVED** the quantity **SHIPPED** and **BILLED**.
